

TRIPS: FULL-SEASON CAMPER TRIPS & TRIP DAYS

Manitou campers and staff leave our grounds at various times during the week. Each group is always given a mobile phone in case there are emergencies or the group needs to contact camp. In addition, campers and staff are required to wear Manitou shirts to make themselves more identifiable to each other. When appropriate, campers are also given spending money from their camper bank fund account.

Full Season Camper Trips

All Full Season campers get to participate in one of our extended trip options that occur over the changeover period in the middle of the summer. The trips are grouped according to age with older campers have longer trips than younger camper staying closer to camp. A complete list of this year's full-season camper trips will be sent separately. Here is a sampling of trips done in the past to give you an idea:

Cooperstown (8th, 9th and 10th graders)

A complete four-day trip to the home of baseball. Includes several fun and exciting stops along the way, attend a minor league game, visit the Hall of Fame, and the opportunity to play a baseball game on Double Day Field (the site of baseball's first game).

The Ultimate Outdoor Adventure Trip (8th, 9th and 10th graders)

The first day of this trip will be spent rafting Maine's most thrilling section of the Kennebec River (unlike last year, this will be different than our usual trip day). Later that day, the group will set up camp at a nearby state park and enjoy a night of real camping. The next morning, some group members will head to Kennebunk for a day of real surfing (with lessons!) while other will go mountain biking in the White Mountains

Golf Plus (6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th graders)

Wanna be Tiger Woods? Campers will get an opportunity to play three of Maine's top golf courses including two top 100 public courses as named by Golf Digest.

Six Flags New England (6th and 7th graders)

A complete New England trip to the areas best amusement park. Includes an exciting water and land ride section. Campers will also get to see the interactive Basketball Hall of Fame and some other great sites of New England.

Southern Maine Camping and Aquaboggin Waterpark (2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th graders)

Manitou younger campers get an exciting trip to Maine's premier waterpark center and experience some incredible outdoor camping in the southern woods of Maine.
